Annual Report of the Policing and Community Safety Authority for 2025 in accordance with Section 22 of the Protected Disclosures Act 2014, as amended

The Policing and Community Safety Authority was established on 2 April 2025, following the commencement of the Policing, Security and Community Safety Act 2024. It is a successor organisation to the Policing Authority (and Garda Síochána Inspectorate) taking on most of their existing functions. Accordingly, this report covers the Policing Authority from 1 January to 1 April 2025 and the Policing and Community Safety Authority from 2 April 2025 to 31 December 2025.

There were no Protected Disclosures made to either the Policing Authority or to the Policing and Community Safety Authority in 2025.

Section 22 of the Protected Disclosures Act 2014, as amended, requires the publication of a report by public bodies each year relating to the number of Protected Disclosures made in the preceding year and of actions taken in response to protected disclosures made. This report must not result in persons making disclosures being identifiable.

The Policing and Community Safety Authority has put in place procedures for the making of protected disclosures in line with the Protected Disclosures Act, as amended. These set out in detail the process by which a worker of the Authority can make a protected disclosure, what will happen, when a disclosure is made and what the Authority will do to protect the discloser. The process supports the Authority's commitment to fostering an environment where everyone who works at the Authority feels able to "speak-up".
